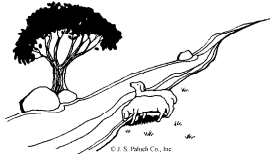

April 3, 2011

The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not want.

– Psalm 23:1

LIGHT

“Awake, O sleeper, and arise from the dead, and Christ will give you light” (Ephesians 5:14). We are at the midpoint of our Lenten journey of conversion. As always, God never gives up on us, especially those who have “fallen asleep” along the road to conversion. The most



powerful stories of conversion are proclaimed during these final weeks of Lent. They have the power to shake us out of our sleep. Today’s Gospel story of the healing of the man born blind exposes the real blindness in the time of Christ—the blindness of the self-righteous religious leaders. In a few weeks, at the Easter Vigil, the Church will proclaim “Christ our Light” as the paschal candle is carried into darkened churches throughout the world. May the darkness of sin that still pervades our lives, communities, and world, be dispelled by the Christ who comes to bring sight to the blind and light to the world. © Copyright, J. S. Paluch Co.

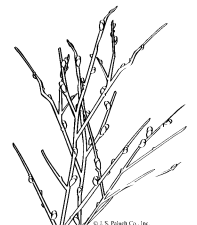

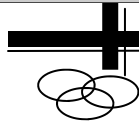

Did You Know?

Review the Body Safety Rules that 'Keep Kids Safe'

April is national Child Abuse Prevention Month, and "Keep Kids Safe" month in the Archdiocese. This month, parents and guardians should review with their children and teens the "Five Body Safety Rules." These rules will help them to protect themselves from the harm of child sexual abuse. Rule #1: It's My Body – God wants me to be safe and happy. I have the right to know the body safety rules. Rule #2: If I have the "Uh-Oh" feeling like something is wrong, then I am right! I need to ask questions. Rule #3: If someone makes me feel uncomfortable, I have the right to say "NO!" and "GET AWAY!" Rule #4: I should always tell if someone makes me feel uncomfortable or touches my private areas. I should keep telling until someone believes me. Rule #5: If I am abused, it is never my fault. Regla #4 Debo de reportar pronto si alguien me hace sentirme inquieto y nervioso o me toca mis partes privadas. Debo de reportar esto seguido hasta que alguien me lo crea. 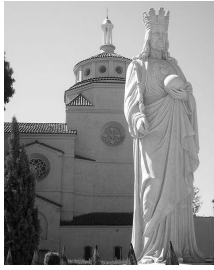

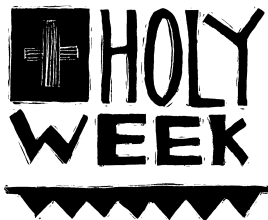
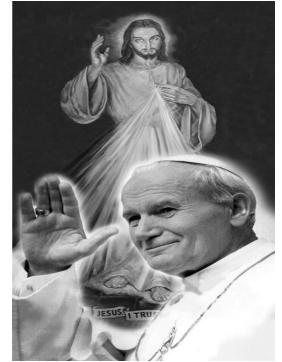
