SEEDS OF FAITH

There is a brevity, a certain terseness, in the scripture readings for Easter Sunday. Peter's speech in Acts is built of direct, pointed sentences. Paul's letters are based on straightforward creed-like statements. Even the Gospel story only briefly recounts what will turn out to be one of the most remarkable events in human history—the resurrection of Jesus from the dead. Advertising agents call these encapsulated points of information “bullet points.” Scripture scholars call them *kerygma*, or “kernels” of our faith. Actually, “kernels” or “seeds” are good terms for these statements, since throughout the Easter season, we will hear in the Acts of the Apostles, the Letters of Paul and the Gospel accounts of the days following the Resurrection, exactly how these *kerygma* began to flower, how they continued to grow through the life of the early church. May these Easter “seeds” of faith serve a similar purpose for us, too, so that the life of the Risen Christ will flourish in us and through our witness in the coming days. ©

FEAST OF FAITH

The Eucharist: Food for Resurrection

How do we celebrate Easter, the greatest of our Christian feasts? By doing what we do every Sunday and every day: celebrating the Mass. On the first Easter, as the heartbroken disciples walked the road to Emmaus, the Lord was with them but they did not realize it. They only recognized him “in the breaking of the bread” (Luke 22:35).

It is the same for us. In the Mass—the breaking of the bread—we meet the risen Lord together. We meet him in each other—for by our baptism into his death and resurrection, we have become members of one body, the Body of Christ. We meet him in his word—in the liturgy the scriptures are proclaimed to us, that they might take root and grow in us. And we meet him in a special way in the Eucharist, the sacrament of his Body and Blood, which is food for resurrection: “whoever eats this bread will live forever” (John 6:51). The Lord is risen indeed, and it is the Risen One who truly presides at this and every Eucharist. —Corinna Laughlin, ©

The Need of Christ the King Remembered by Our Beloved Former Pastor, Msgr. Alexander C. George

On April 22, 2010, Cardinal Roger Mahony, Archbishop of Los Angeles, accepted the Msgr. Alexander C. George Endowment Trust Fund for Christ the King Church, an Autonomous Pious Foundation.

As many of you know, Msgr. George was the fourth pastor of Christ the King, appointed by Cardinal Timothy Manning on November 1, 1979. In his 20 years as pastor, Msgr. George created a parish of community and spirituality. He counseled the troubled, fed the homeless, and provided help and guidance to parishioners in need of housing, legal aid, and financial assistance. To this day, Msgr. George continues his ministry to help the less fortunate in our parish community by creating the Endowment Fund for Christ the King Church.

Once the pledge payments have exceeded our goal, our parish will receive all of the additional funds for use in our parish ministries.

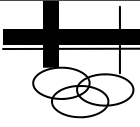

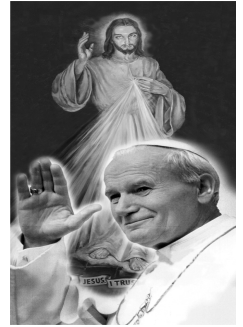

Jesus said: "I desire that there be a Feast of Mercy. I want this image, which you will paint with a brush, to be solemnly blessed on the first Sunday after Easter; that Sunday is to be the Feast of Mercy" (*Diary 49*).

I want to grant a complete pardon to the souls that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion on the Feast of My mercy. (*Diary 1109*)

The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall *obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment.* (*Diary 699*).

This is a day of total forgiveness of sins for those who approach the Eucharist and the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

Jesus has attributed the power to remit sins and punishment to Holy Communion received on the Feast of Mercy, thereby elevating it to the rank of "Second Baptism".

To observe the Feast of Mercy, we should:

1. **Celebrate** the Feast on the first Sunday after Easter;
2. Sincerely **Repent** of all our sins;
3. Place our complete **Trust in Jesus**;
4. Go to **Confession**, preferably before the Divine Mercy Sunday;
5. Receive **Holy Communion** on the day of the Feast;
6. **Venerate the Image** of the Merciful Jesus
7. **Be merciful to others**, through our actions, words, and prayers on their behalf.

At Christ the King in preparation for the DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY we will start the Divine Mercy Novena on April 22 and end it on April 30, 2011.
