Sunday, May 15th, 2011 marks the 48th World Day for Vocations. Pope Paul VI instituted the World Day of Prayer for Vocations (the 4th Sunday of Easter) on the 11th April 1964 by stating:

"O Jesus, divine Shepherd of the spirit, you have called the Apostles in order to make them fishermen of men, you still attract to you burning spirits and generous young people, in order to render them your followers and ministers to us" (Pope Paul VI launching the 1st World Day of Prayer for Vocations) "The ability to foster vocations is a hallmark of the vitality of a local Church. With trust and perseverance let us invoke the aid of the Virgin Mary, that by the example of her own acceptance of God's saving plan and her powerful intercession, every community will be more and more open to saying "yes" to the Lord who is constantly calling new labourers to his harvest. With this hope, I cordially impart to all my Apostolic Blessing."

Once the pledge payments have exceeded our goal, our parish will receive all of the additional funds for use in our parish ministries.

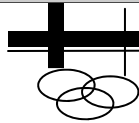

**Monitoring Your Child's Text
Messages**

Recent news reports included the story of a 35-year-old man exchanging explicit text messages with a 14-year-old girl. Being able to recognize text messaging "meeting codes" can help parents be more effective monitors of their child's safety. Meeting codes are used by strangers to gain information about people they don't know or to arrange a first meeting. They can be used between friends, but most are more commonly used in other circumstances. For example, "S2R" means "Send to receive (pictures)," and "WYRN" means "What's your real name?" A helpful tutorial for parents is located at www.mahalo.com. Type: "How to understand your kids' text messages" in the search box. Los códigos de reunión son utilizados por extraños para obtener información personal sobre alguna persona o para organizar una primera reunión. Los códigos se pueden utilizar entre amigos, pero la mayoría se usan mas frecuente en otras circunstancias.
